



M TECH SCHOLARSHIP SCHEMES – 2016 Admission

Sl No	Scholarship	Eligibility	Description
1	The Archbishop's Scholarship for AISAT Alumni	AISAT Alumni & students of sister institutions	40% scholarship in Tuition fees. (Effective fee : Rs.39,000/-)
2	Merit Scholarship	B Tech CGPA > 7.0 or equivalent percentage	40 % scholarship in Tuition fees. (Effective fee : Rs.39,000/-)
3	Progressive Scholarship	M Tech S1 CGPA > 7.5	40 % scholarship in Tuition fees in subsequent semesters. (Effective fee : Rs.39,000/-)
4	Scholarship for Economically backward students	Scholarship for Economically backward and academically brilliant students (less than Rs 4.0 lakhs per annum)	Full tuition fee scholarship for one student.

GUIDELINES FOR SCHOLARSHIP SCHEMES

1. A student can avail any one of the above scholarship schemes. At the time of admission a student can apply for any one of 1, 2 or 4 schemes. Scholarship schemes are applicable to both GATE and Non- GATE applicants.
2. Merit Scholarship is awarded based on the CGPA/percentage at the time of admission. After the publication of final result, if the CGPA falls below 7.0, the scholarship will be cancelled.
3. Students who are not under the category of 1, 2 or 4 can apply for Progressive scholarship at the end of Semester I. If the S1 CGPA > 7.5, scholarship can be availed in S2, and if S2 CGPA > 7.5, scholarship can be availed in S3 and so on.
4. Scholarships are liable to be withdrawn, partially or wholly, in case of misconduct, deliberate concealment of materials/facts and/or supply of false information, and/or continued absence of more than one month except on medical grounds.



- Scholarships are liable to be reduced or terminated for a period of up to one semester on account of poor academic performance or not carrying out the assigned tasks in a satisfactory manner.

ASSISTANTSHIP SCHEMES

Sl. No	Scholarship	Eligibility	Description
1	Principal's Teaching/ Graduate/ Research Assistantship	20 % of the sanctioned intake of students (Appointment for academic semester only-till last working day)	Earn up to Rs.6,000/- per month for non-GATE students.

GUIDELINES FOR ASSISTANTSHIP SCHEMES

- Students can apply for Assistantship Schemes through Department. Selection of the same will be done by Department Assistantship Selection Committee and vetting through PG Scholarship Management Cell.
- Decision of PG Scholarship Management Cell is final and binding.
- GATE students are not eligible for remuneration as they receive other stipends.
- Scholarships are liable to be terminated for a period on account of poor academic performance or not carrying out the assigned tasks in a satisfactory manner.
