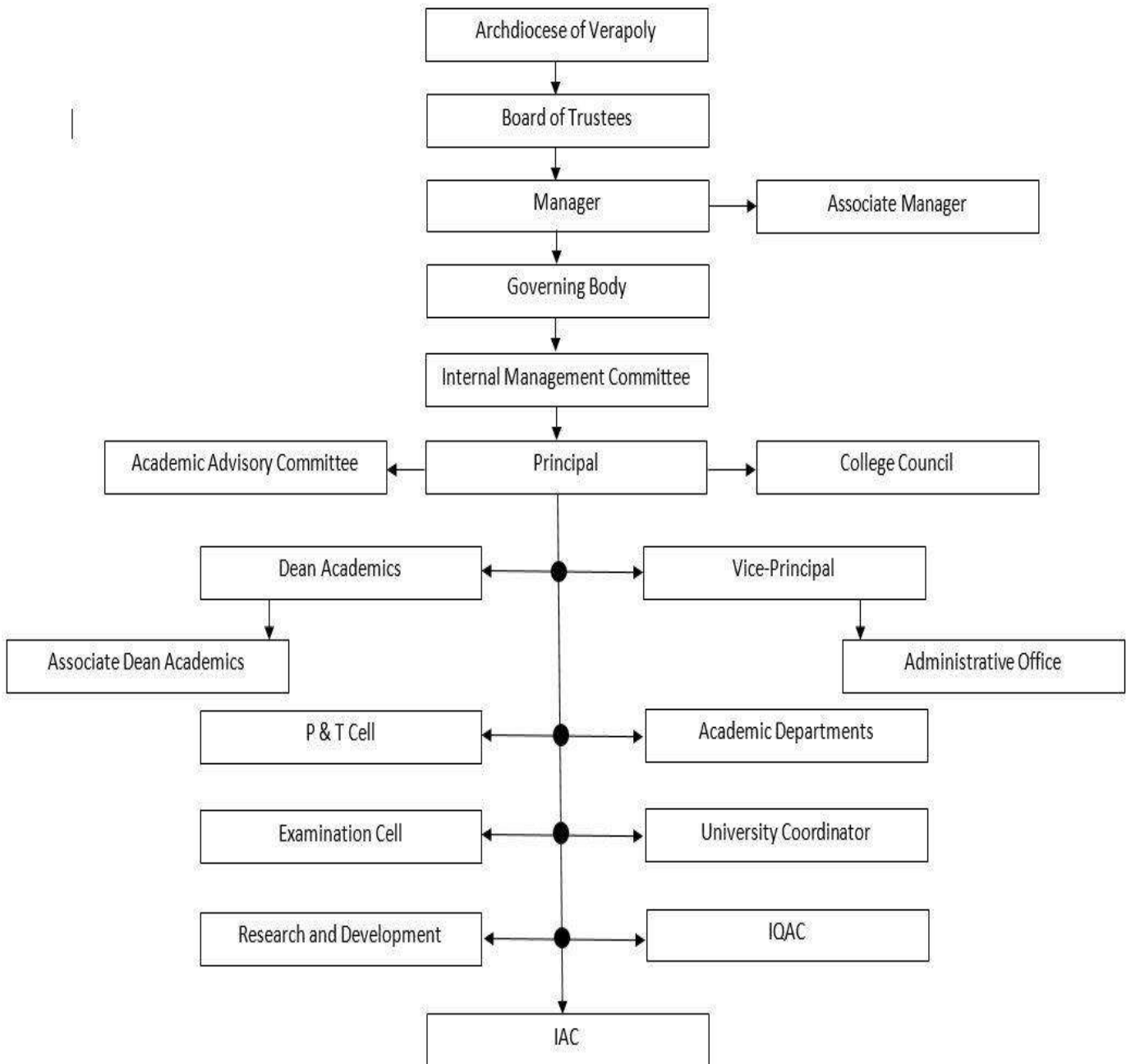

### Faculty Feedback

A standard questionnaire is framed and students are asked to submit their responses online.

This feedback is collected twice per every semester. The responses for questions are on a scale of 5 with the following interpolation:

1 - Strongly Disagree, 2 - Disagree, 3 - Neutral, 4 - Agree, 5 - Strongly Agree

Based on the responses, the Teaching Effectiveness Index (TEI) is calculated out of 50. The feedback and their TEI are communicated to the respective faculty members, so that they can understand their strengths and weaknesses. HOD communicates with the concerned faculties to appreciate or suggest necessary improvements in teaching.

**Management Seats: Remaining 50% seats are Management seats, allotted on merit by ranking applicants on the basis of marks obtained for PCM (12th standard only) and for Kerala Engineering Entrance Examination. Candidates who have passed Higher Secondary Examination, Kerala, or Examinations recognized as equivalent thereto, with 45 % marks in Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry/equivalent subjects put together or equivalent grade are eligible for admission.**

**NRI: 15% of seats (9 seats) within sanctioned intake (60 seats) is provided for NRI category and is given on first come- first serve basis. To get admission in NRI quota, the applicant need not be qualified in Kerala Entrance Exam. 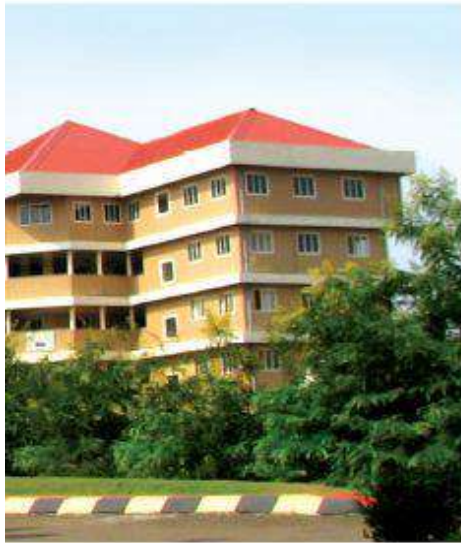
